Parashat KI TAVO... contains a lengthy list of blessings and curses. In this passage, Moses reminds the children of Israel that the fate of the

nation is indeed directed by the cumulative choices of individuals. Nevertheless, the horrendous curses detailed in the parashah are meted out <u>only</u> to the community; Heavenly punishment for an individual's transgressions is not described here. Elsewhere the Torah affirms that each individual is punished by G-d - by methods known only to the inscrutable Master of the Universe - for his or her own sin, not the wrong actions of others.
