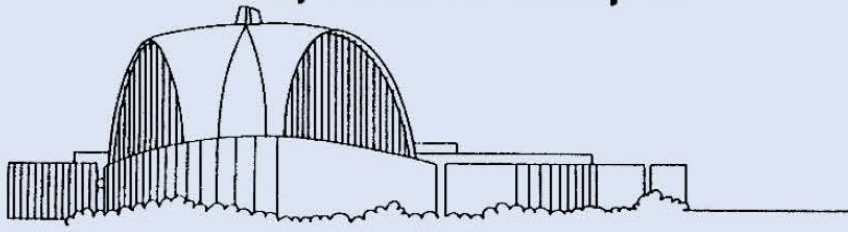

It is obscene and a lie to continue to mourn for a building. The fact that Tish'ah Be'Av does not focus solely on one event (cf. Mishnah Ta'anit 4:6) - but even more so makes the most recent communal tragedy central to the day's observance - means that the observances of self-denial must lead to teshuvah. For our generation that would be the Holocaust, and again not to wallow in misery - but as Isaiah teaches us "חֲרָצְבוֹת רָשָׁע פִּתְחָם" (58:6), the mourning that one experiences on a fast day is to make us alert, to think about how many things we could have averted and to gain the resolve to act differently and more wisely the next time.



Parashat DEVARIM... The fifth, and last, book of the Pentateuch/Humash was known in ancient times as 'Mishneh Torah' - the Repetition of Torah. This name refers to the fact that Devarim restates much of the essential teachings, principles, and history of our ancient Israelite ancestors. Not simply repetitive, however, Devarim/Deuteronomy gives new depth and meaning to many of the Torah's teachings.

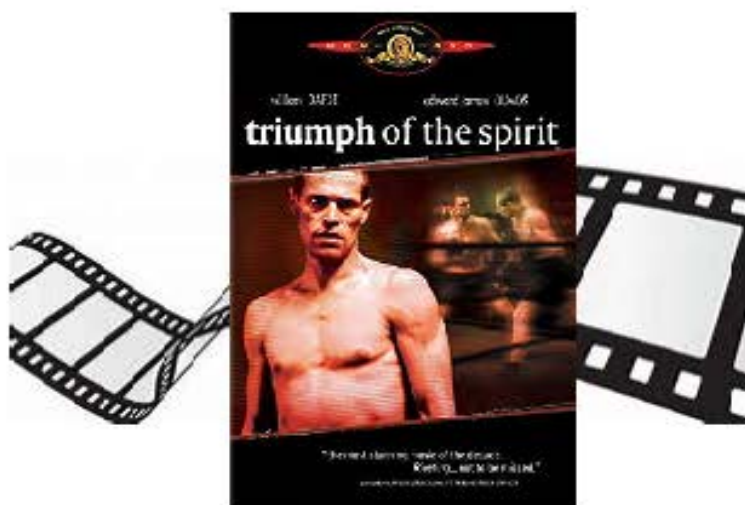
