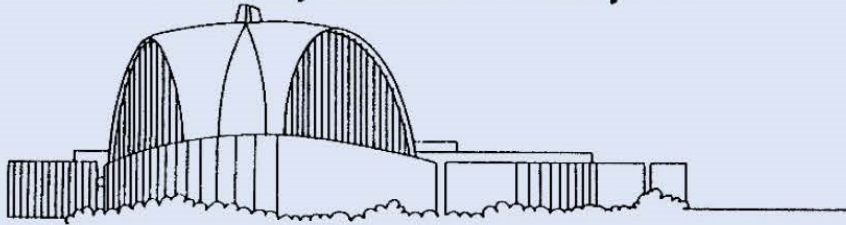

PARSHAT AHARE MOT describes the atonement rite for Yom Kippur; it also presents laws which deal with unlawful marriages. Both sections of Ahare Mot are also read on Yom Kippur. The Rabbis explained this combination of two diverse themes by noting that the act of atonement is never complete by the purification rite alone - only when the values expressed in the purification ritual become part of the family's life. Repentance and moral excellence, like "charity", begin at home.

PARSHAT KEDOSHIM spans two chapters - Leviticus 19 & 20 - of the Holiness Code (a distinct unit whose central idea is that the entire people Israel bears the responsibility of seeking to achieve holiness). The commandments of chapter 19 cut across all categories of life. They deal with ritual, with business ethics, with proper behavior toward the poor and the afflicted, and with family relations. The modern distinction between 'religious' and 'secular' is unknown to the Torah.
