FROM THE DESK OF RABBI GOLDEN

At our recent gathering of snowbirds in Boca Raton last month, I was able to congratulate Marion Crespi in person on being chosen as this year's Journal Honoree. And in support of our fundraising for the Journal, I shared with those in attendance a brief thought about the Shema Yisrael prayer.

We are all familiar with the second line of the Shema: "And you shall love the L-rd your G-d with all your heart, and with all your soul, UBKHOL ME'ODEKHA - and with all your might" (Deuteronomy 6:5). ME'OD is a biblical Hebrew word that means "abundant", and it's use here means that we should love G-d "exceedingly". Curiously we find it taking a possessive only one other time in all of Scripture: the story of King Josiah where he is described as an unparalleled devoted leader who served G-d "with all his heart, all his soul, and all <u>his</u> might".

Many of us are puzzled - and even saddened - by the Talmudic Sages' interpretation of the word ME'ODEKHA in our verse. They taught that the mitsvah to love G-d UBKHOL ME'ODEKHA means to love G-d 'with all your money' - an idea that seems mismatched with the lofty ideals of heart and soul. Nevertheless, we all can see the value of placing our spiritual and material resources foremost in the service of The Holy One.

When it comes to your participation in this year's Journal, I hope that you will be motivated to give as generously as possible - 'with all <u>your</u> might' - in honor of Marion. She has guided her family to hold fast to their Sephardic roots and to see the Sephardic Temple as their spiritual home. Marion is a true leader, and sets the best example: participate as often as possible in synagogue activities - religious and social - with all your heart, with all your soul and with all your might.

Shira and I send warmest wishes and congratulations to Marion and her entire family, and eagerly look forward to seeing everyone celebrate with her on Shabbat, June 22, 2024.
