

SELLING THE “HAMETS” Form 2024/5784

The Torah forbids a Jew to own any hamets during Passover, so we sell all hamets (left after the search and burning) to a non-Jew, with the Rabbi acting as our agent. The non-Jewish buyer gives a small deposit, and the balance becomes a guaranteed loan. The sale of hamets transaction is legally binding, but the buyer may return it and retrieve his deposit. Place all hamets utensils in a specific room or closet(s) to be sold, sealed with tape or lock, from Monday, April 22, at 10:30 AM until after Passover, Tuesday April 30, at 9:30 PM.
