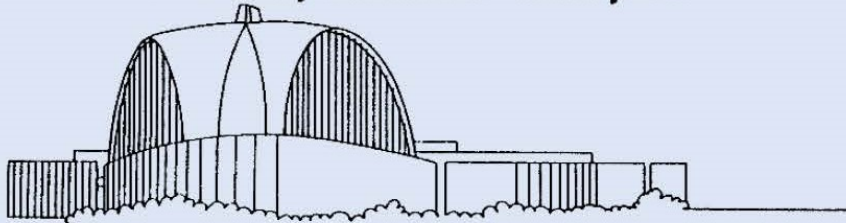

Parashat KI TISSA... There is a critical difference between the first and second experiences of Moses on Mount Sinai. The Torah states that the first set of tablets 'were the work of G-d'. For the second set, however, G-d told Moses to carve the two stone tablets himself. The first set of tablets was a gift; the second set required Moses to do the work himself. Therein lies the greatness of Moses: the strength to climb the mountain a second time. Moses discovered the wherewithal not to give up, not to despair, even after crisis and tragedy, to somehow locate the resources to climb the mountain a second time. The first set of tablets was a gift. It is very difficult to fully appreciate a gift. The second set of tablets was the product of difficult but sincere human labor and persistence. Only these tablets would remain intact.
