Parashat **MATTOT-MAS'EI**... PARASHAT MATTOT opens with a discussion of the binding nature of vows. The Torah teaches us that words should not be taken lightly and that all vows made in the name of G-d must be fulfilled. In PARASHAT MAS'EI, Israel's sojourn in the wilderness was more than a physical journey. When the children of Israel crossed the Reed Sea, they entered upon an odyssey which involved an inner soul journey as well as a trip to Canaan. Forty years of wandering in the wilderness allowed the community of Israel to rediscover its true identity. In a sense, that journey is symbolic of each person's journey through life. All of us begin as little more than slaves subject to the forces of nature and society that surround us. When we end our journey we should be independent and self-reliant human beings who have discovered our true selves.
