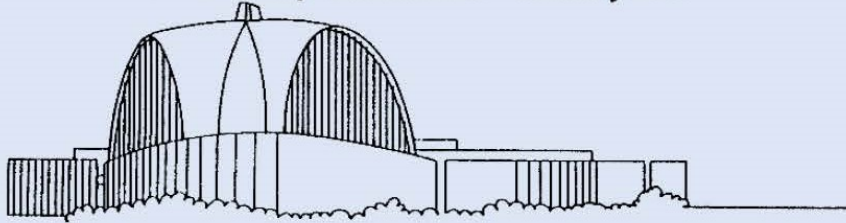

Parashat NASSO... is the longest parashah in the entire Torah. The Hebrew name of the portion connects to its four themes. Nasso means 'to count'. At first, the reading continues the accounting of the tribe of Levi. The second portion deals with trust and doubt in marriage, which is called Nisu'in (from a root similar to 'Nasso'). The third describes the laws of the Nazirite - one who devotes him/herself to G-d through ascetic practices. The final section describes the special sacrifices of the Nisi'im (the princes) of the tribes of Israel.
