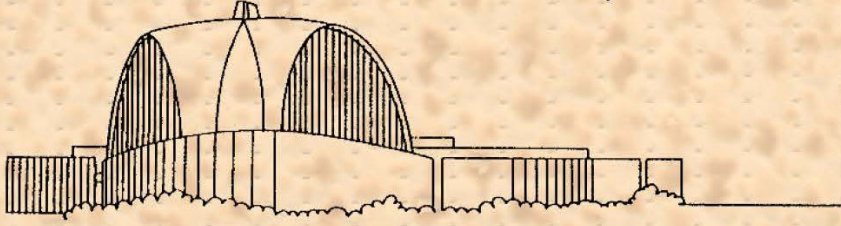

Parashah of the Book of Leviticus describes several types of sacrifices that

the Israelites brought to the Tabernacle. Though far removed from our contemporary reality, we should try to understand what they meant to our ancient ancestors. Among the offerings were several sacrifices that were brought by individuals to repair their relationship with G-d after incidents of breakdown. "...And it will be forgiven him for anything of all that he has done wherein to incur guilt." (Lev. 5:26) Each sin offering was accompanied by a personal admission of guilt and contrition for previous actions.

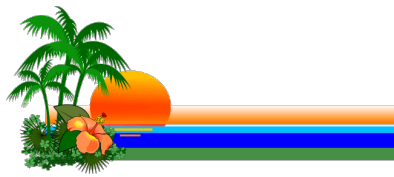
