Moses discovered the wherewithal not to give up, not to despair, even after crisis and tragedy, to somehow locate the resources to climb the mountain a second time. The first set of tablets was a gift. It is very difficult to fully appreciate a gift. The second set of tablets was the product of difficult but sincere human labor and persistence. Only these tablets would remain intact.
