


A Salute to Mel Matsil






ISAAC H. ZACHARIA תנצב"ה Honorary Chairman of the Board

The weekday chapel entrance was rebuilt, enlarged and refurbished with new sculptured doors and the chapel foyer was refurbished, including chandeliers and carpeting. The main entrance was reconstructed by widening the driveway, eliminating the steps, building a large marquee over the main entrance and installing new sets of sculptured doors, which have magnificently enhanced the main entrance.

We would like to thank the late **Mr. Joseph Camhi** for undertaking the initiative of this grand project that added to the grandeur of the Sephardic Temple.



A SHORT HISTORY OF THE SEPHARDIC TEMPLE

of their elders organized a new congregation in the New Lots section of Brooklyn. This new congregation, called The United Sephardim of Brooklyn, accented a program of youth activities and services for young adults. It reorganized the religious school and utilized the existing facilities of the Williams Avenue synagogue and the Malta Street synagogue. The congregation flourished and achieved a singular reputation in the Sephardic community.

In the late 1950's the neighborhood began to change and Irving L. Rousso, who was a vice-president of the United Sephardim of Brooklyn was asked to head a committee to establish a new congregation in the Five Towns area. Under his leadership meetings were held in the homes of many prominent Sephardim who lived in the Five Towns and a strong nucleus of leaders undertook the creation of The Sephardic Temple. A large parcel of land was acquired on of The Sephardic Temple. A large parcel of land was acquired on Branch Boulevard and our magnificent edifice was erected. The doors of the completed building were opened for the Pesach holidays of 1964.

On the following pages we have highlighted events and happenings to recall these past years. We hope that you will remember these moments and enjoy these memories.








The rough plumbing is complete. The building has five comfort-room areas, a meat kitchen, a dairy kitchen and a custodian's apartment.




100 tons of steel rods have been placed into the slab, creating a strong unbreakable floor.

The height of the outside wall is fifteen and a half feet, with large spans of glass curtain walls in certain areas.




To bring out the highlighting tones of the brick, the walls are scrubbed with acid, sanded and washed to a glowing finish.
